Mr Mahen Kundasamy has now taken over as the Chief Executive Officer of the Economic Development Board (EDB).

Mr Kundasamy was at one time the Mauritian Ambassador to South Africa and the High Commissioner for Mauritius to the UK.

With his previous South African experience, the new EDB CEO is regarded as an asset to

That statement was made in the seventies. 50 years later, it may still hold true, when one considers the extent of the claims being made against the Government of Mauritius for damages, or as compensation for alleged illegal treatment.

Emeritus businessman Dawood Rawat is suing the Mauritius Government for two billion rupees for the dismantling of his business empire ten years ago under Finance Minister Vishnu Lutchmeenaraidoo. The latest gladiator to enter the arena is Sher Singh, a fomer CEO of Mauritius Telecom at the time of tenure of office of Pravind Kumar Jugnauth (PKJ) as Prime Minister. According to allegations, Singh was a member of the PM's 'kitchen cabinet' where decisions were made. It was also alleged that he enjoyed the family's swimming pool in the evening.

It is said that familiarity brings contempt. The friendship of Mr Singh and the Jugnauths began to wear thin, and Mr Singh and the Jugnauths fell out . . . at some stage. Mr Singh lost his Mauritius Telecom CEO job, and with his wife Varusha, was subsequently detained by police on corruption charges. Mr Singh went wild with anger and promised the government of the day a tsunami. By George, a tsunami did take place which wiped out PKJ and his government. In some quarters, it is believed that Mr Singh may have been responsible for more than meet the eyes.

As part of his vindication. Mr Singh is now suing the Mauritius Government in the sum of 450 million rupees for himself and Rs300 million rupees for his wife on the grounds that they were wrongfully arrested. It was a **political vendetta**, he claims.

Political vendetta! this is what the leader of the Opposition, Joe Lesongard, said at the MSM press conference about the arrest and rearrest of the former Finance Minister, Mr Renganaden Padayachy. Other high officials of the previous administration are equally being arrested, detained and investigated regarding allocation of contracts, purchase of commodities, and whatnot! Under investigation by the Financial Crimes Commission at the very moment are Rajiv Servansingh, outgoing director of the State Trading Corporation (STC) and Kareena Neisius, director of the Mercantile & Maritime Group


The Pope was aware of the ill-treatment and the deportation of Latin Americans from the US to Venezuelan and other jails. The Pope himself was of Latin American origin.
